
Are you or your children exposed to humiliation, insults, threats, violence?

You do not have to endure such a situation!

The Protection against Violence Act (Gewaltschutzgesetz) has been in force since 1 January 2002.

This law strengthens your rights and your ability to protect yourself.

We support you in asserting your rights under the Protection against Violence Act. Under this law, it is no longer the victims of violence who need to leave their home, but the perpetrators.



Counseling centre

- We provide counseling and support to women who are seeking help to end domestic violence.
- We provide advice and information to professionals, relatives and cooperating authorities and institutions.
- We provide counseling on all forms of domestic violence, be it of a psychological, physical, sexual, economic, or social nature.
- We also advise on issues such as stalking, impending 'honor' killings, forced marriage and digital violence.
- Our counseling services are available to all women, regardless of origin or residence status.
- Our counseling services are provided free of charge and on a non-denominational basis.
- All information is treated as confidential and, if desired, provided anonymously.



What we offer

- Clarification of your personal situation, design of a personalized safety plan
- Information on legal issues within the framework of the Protection Against Violence Act, support in applying for protection orders and housing assignment, accompaniment to court on request
- Psychological and social counseling
- Information on separation and divorce
- Information on custody and visitation rights regarding your child
- Assistance with applications for subsistence support
- Information on the support network available to prevent violence, referral to other counseling centres, specialized services, authorities and institutions, as necessary
